

Size: 10 ½" Block unfinished

Colors: Your choices

Cut: One (1) 2 ½" square – will be the corner starting fabric
Four (4) 2 ½" strips of four coordinated fabrics

Assembly: This pattern is intended to make ¼ of a large block so four together will complete the look.

Begin with any color center (red is traditional) and start with a 2 ½" square. Sew a 2 ½" strip of second color on each of two adjacent sides of the 2 ½" square, as shown in the photo, log cabin style. Change to third color and so on until you reach 10 ½" block. Four colors added to the original square should produce a 10 ½" block if you use scant ¼" seams.
