Dear Vendors,

The South Bay Quilters Guild of Torrance, CA is pleased to announce our 2026 quilt show, ***Celebrating the Seasons***, to be held February 14th & 15th, 2026, at the Torrance Cultural Arts Center, 3330 Civic Center Drive, Torrance CA. We are looking forward to an exciting show with many wonderful quilts on display, our Guilds *“Through the Seasons”* Opportunity Quilt, and of course, a great vendor mall!

As we’ve done before, our quilt show will display in the Toyota Meeting Hall with the vendor mall, food court, and raffle baskets in the Ken Miller Recreation Center on the other side of the inner courtyard. Past attendees have told us they look forward to visiting the quilt show vendors as much as seeing the beautiful quilts on display. We hope you will decide to be a part of our show.

- The vendor mall setup is on Friday, February 13th from 2:00pm to 8:00pm.
- Vendors are required to participate on both Saturday and Sunday.
- The show hours for Saturday and Sunday are 10:00am to 4:00pm.
- Vendors will have until 6:30pm on Sunday to break down their booth. We will have assistance if needed.

Vendor space is allocated on a first come, first serve basis. Room location of booths is based on vendor applications received and room layout. In the past three years, all spaces were reserved and we had a waiting list! We recommend sending your application and payment as soon as possible to secure your spot!

The Application form for SBQG Show Vendor Mall is attached. Booth fee includes: Pipe and light gray drape, tables and chairs, and electricity. The Booth fee schedule describes available booth sizes and cost. We should be able to adjust our booth sizes to meet your needs as long as there is open space to do so. Again, earlier application for special space need is suggested.

To secure a booth at SBQG 2026 show, please mail the following items listed below to the address listed on the application:

- 1) The attached 2 page application, completed and signed
- 2) Your check made payable to South Bay Quilters Guild, Inc.

If you reserve now and later need to cancel, your payment is 90% refundable until December 1, 2025, SBQG will retain 10% as cancellation fee. After December 1, regrettably we cannot refund your canceled reservation unless we can fill the space reserved from our wait list. Please be sure to call me as soon as possible if you find you must cancel.

The City of Torrance requires that all vendors purchase a transient business license for the show weekend. You may find the form and information about this license at the City of Torrance website under Business License Applications.

Please note our Sale policy: Vendors may discount their general merchandise up to 15% as desired. Each vendor may also advertise and sell **one** particular item as a "Show Special" up to 20% off regular price. This could include a boxed set of thread, a set of rulers, etc. No further discounts may be given. Feel free to discuss with me your situation.

Thank you for taking the time to look over our show information. Feel free to contact me with any questions. We look forward to another fantastic and inspiring quilt show and vendor mall next February and we hope to see you there!
