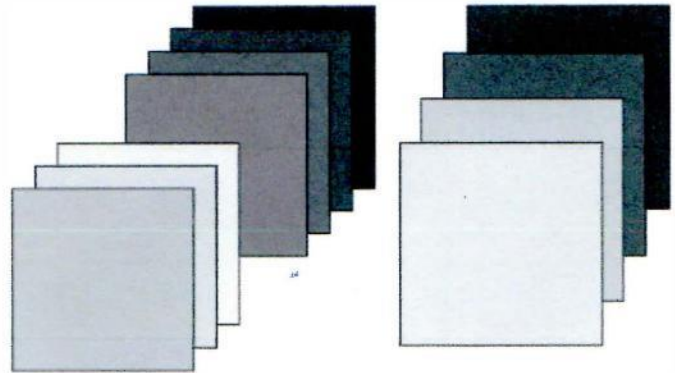
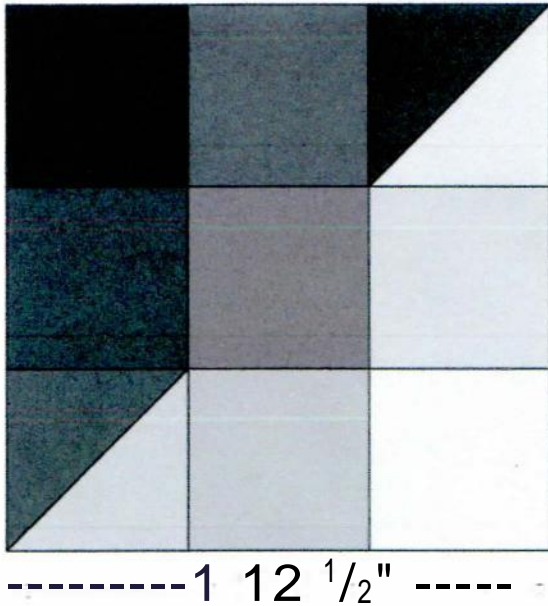


Perkiomen Valley Block (Adapted from Superbuzzy/VMQG 2018)

To make two blocks, use 4 - 5" squares to make 4 half-square triangles, 2 for each block, and do not repeat any fabric in the block. The cutting requirements below are for two blocks.



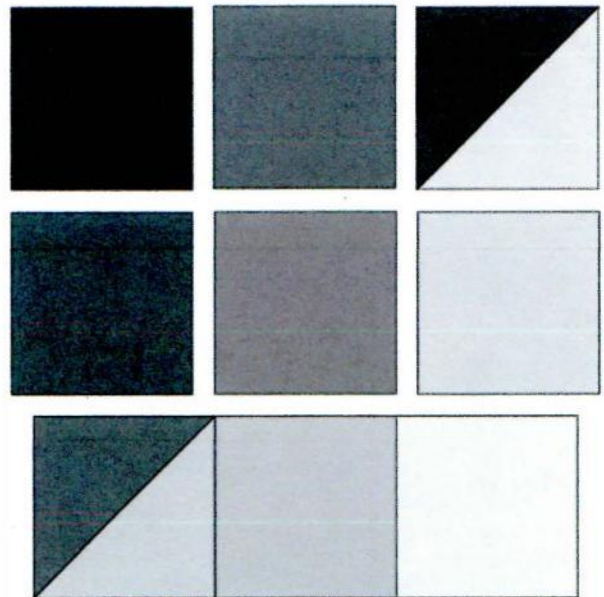
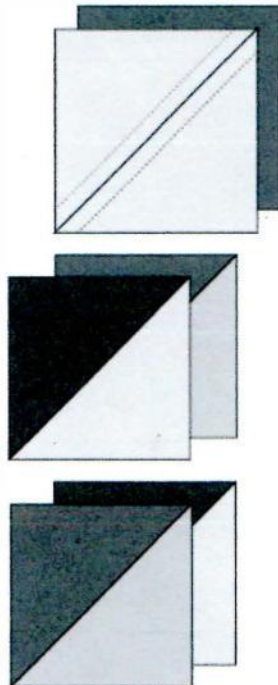
14-4 1/2"
Squares
8 Dark
6 Light

4-5"
Squares
2 Dark
2 Light

Draw a diagonal line on the back of both of the 5" light squares.

Place 1 of the light squares on a 5" dark square, right sides together, and sew a scant 1/4" seam on both sides of the drawn line.

Cut on the drawn line to create 2 half-square triangles, measuring 4 1/2". Repeat with other set and square up. You will end up with 4 half-square triangles (you need 2 for each block, use one of each pair for each block.)



Sew pieces together as illustrated using 1/4" seam allowance.
